The Questions in the SWMTC Learning Journal – MDM I-III

SECTION I – Personal reactions

- a) In particular, what did you find most affirming?**
- b) Most challenging?**
- c) Most relevant to your faith and spirituality?**

SECTION II – Theological reflections

Selecting one theme from the weekend, answer the following questions:

- a) How were scripture, tradition, reason and experience used in the exploration of the theme?**
- b) How were they blended? Was anything missing? Was anything overplayed? Were there any tensions between them?**
- c) What connections can you make with your other theological learning, for example in your evening class modules?**
- d) How has your theological understanding of the theme been affirmed, changed, deepened, challenged?**

[Years 2-3 only: e) Do you see connections between the theological material and your present understanding of what your ministry will be?]

SECTION III – Skills for ministry

- a) What did you do that was new to you?**

- b) What experience of liturgy or prayer was new to you, or struck you in a new way?**
- c) Did you work with others in a new way, or with colleagues with whom you had not worked before?**
- d) Did you gain any new insight into pastoral/professional practice?**
